



The meaning of the Logo Ombudsman

The logo of the Ombudsman Aruba features the colors of the Aruban flag, which symbolizes a strong connection with the identity and values of our island.

The black letter "O" in the logo refers to "Ombudsman".

While the letter "D" comes from the Papiamentu language and stands for "Defensor di Pueblo".

The term "Defensor di Pueblo" means "Defender of the People," which emphasizes the Ombudsman's role as guardian and protector of the people.

There are two rings in the colors of the Aruban flag around the "O". These rings symbolize protection and the care the Ombudsman provides to the community.

The triple lines in both the "D" and the "O" refer to the foundations of Aruba's constitution, which embody the basic principles of good governance, transparency, and accountability.

Together, this logo forms a powerful symbol of the Ombudsman's dedication to protecting and defending the rights and interests of all residents of Aruba.
